Draw trees for the following sentences. You must label all the categories in the tree:

- (1) I said that you will have to draw trees for Quiz 3
- (2) To draw trees is fun
- (3) Drawing trees is fun
- (4) John's talking in class made the teacher angry
- (5) The students hate to parse sentences
- (6) That Homer loves beer is known to everyone

For the sentences on pp. 221-224

1. Locate and identify each subordinate clause as a that-clause, wh-clause, relative clause, or adverb clause. Then do the following:

- a) State the role of the clause in the sentence

Note that for that-clauses and wh-clauses the role must be some type of NP (NP:Subj, NP:DO, etc.)

For adverb clauses, the role is always Adv.

For relative clauses, the role is always Adj.

- b) Identify all WhSubs and state their role within the noun clause (NP:Subj, NP:DO, Adverb, etc.)

2. Locate and identify each non-finite verbal as a gerund phrase, a participial phrase or an infinitive phrase. Then do the following:

- a) Identify its role in the sentence

Note that for gerund phrases, the role must be some type of NP.

For participial phrases in this exercise, the role must be Adj.

For infinitive phrases, the role can be NP, Adv, Comp to Adj, or Comp to NP.

- â b) Analyze the internal structure of each phrase by identifying the verbal type (VT, VI, Vc, etc) and any NP: Subj, NP: DO, NP: IO, NP:PN, or NP:OC within the phrase.
