I. Parse each sentence using ONLY the labels in the list (3 pts. per sentence) [27pts total]

DefArt, IndefArt, N, PropN, GenN, DemonD, DemonPro, PossPronD, Pro, IndPossPron, Adj, Adv, Prep, Modal, NEG, Caten, Aux, VI, VL, VT, Vg, Vc, BE, Comp, Prt, Qual, CoordConj, SubConj, Expl

1. People could become sick from eating unwashed fruit
2. The boy saw the pink elephant in his room
3. Anyone can learn grammar

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Example parsing sentence 3 = Pron ModalAux VT N

II. Identify the grammatical role of each underlined unit by stating whether its function is Subj, DO, IO, OC, PN, PADj, PP, Adv. If it is none of these, write "none". (1 pt. each) [8pts]

1. John and Bill became very famous

Example: John and Bill = subject

2. Everyone considers Bush a terrible president.
3. We ate pizza last night

III. Identify the requested parts of each sentence. If a requested part does not actually occur in the sentence, write "none". (1 pt. per item) [6 pts total]

1. We had arrived by the time John finished dinner

a) Tense (morphological)	b) Voice	c) Mood
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Example: a) Tense = past b) Voice = active c) Mood = indicative

2. Classes were being cancelled because of bad weather

a) Tense	b) Aspect	c) Mood
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IV. Give an example of the following: (2 points each) [6pts total]

1. A grammatical sentence containing a **Vg** in **passive** voice.

Example for 1. = John was given a book by Bill

2. A grammatical sentence containing a **VLink** in **present tense** with **progressive** aspect.
3. A grammatical sentence containing an inflectional 'ed' affix.
